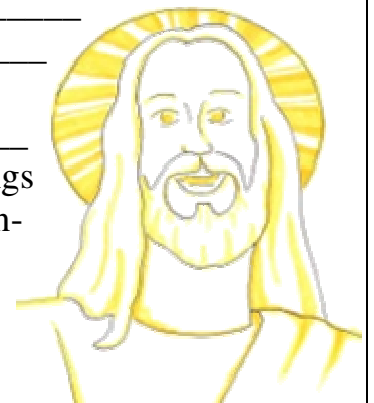
The word Christ, often used as a last name for Jesus, is really a title taken from the Greek word Christos which means the anointed one, or Messiah. The term is a bit lost on us Gentiles, but to the Jews it was rich with meaning and history. In the Old Testament, the priests, kings, and at times, prophets were 'anointed ones', a sign of God's selection and approval of the men filling these sacred offices. Above them all was the promised Messiah, the Prophet, Priest and King to come who would be Savior to all. Interestingly, the Jews of New Testament times saw much more of the Old Testament as being about the Messiah than we do as Christians today. They were certainly not guilty of neglecting or ignoring Scripture, their mistake was in holding such a narrow view of what Scripture said that they failed to recognize the Messiah that came to them. (Unger 839-840) I have to admit that I am not so certain that I would have recognized Him either. Imagine someone coming into your church and turning everything topsy-turvy. When all the prophecies are taken together, we find that Jesus did indeed come at just the right time and place. According to mathematician Peter W. 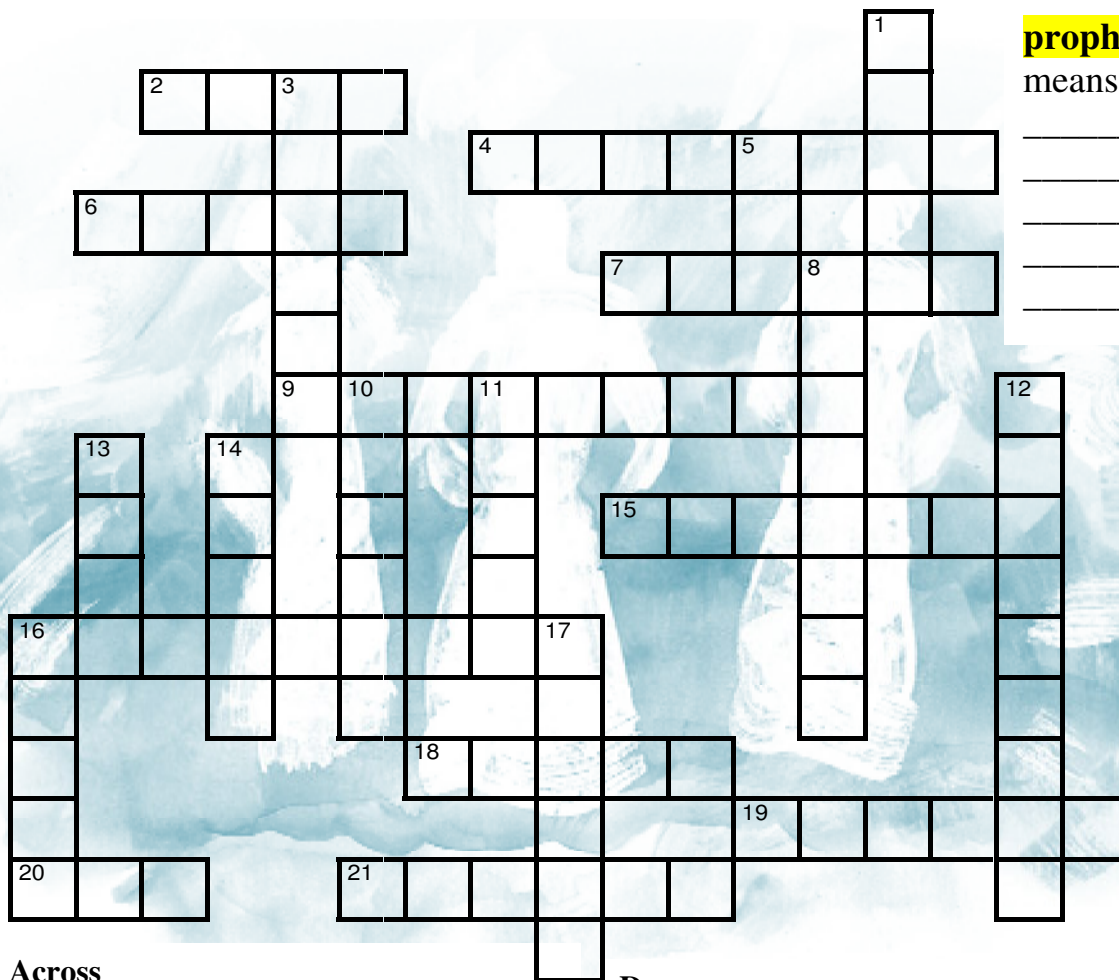
