WHAT THE WORLD SAYS ABOUT JESUS

People around us still find the identity and teachings of Jesus hard to swallow. A basic Christian belief is that Jesus is the only route to spending eternity with the Father, and He is, in fact, one with the Father. He is the Son of God, born of a virgin and without sin. He was crucified and rose on the third day. There are many different, and more popular, messages being delivered today. People listen to spiritual advice from a lot more places than just church. In one poll, a third of the people said that Oprah has had more influence on what they believe spiritually than preachers have. (Lutzer 117) Fictional books that are contrary to the truth of Scripture have had enormous popularity. Christians are often made to look foolish, or even cruel, for believing what the Bible has to say about Jesus. Others accept a Jesus that has been reshaped to be a little more like what our **culture** values. Many Americans value His compassion and His stands for social justice, but believe that He sinned, and question His deity. He is seen as only one of many ways to heaven, and when we speak the truth there are many who will say "Nonsense!"

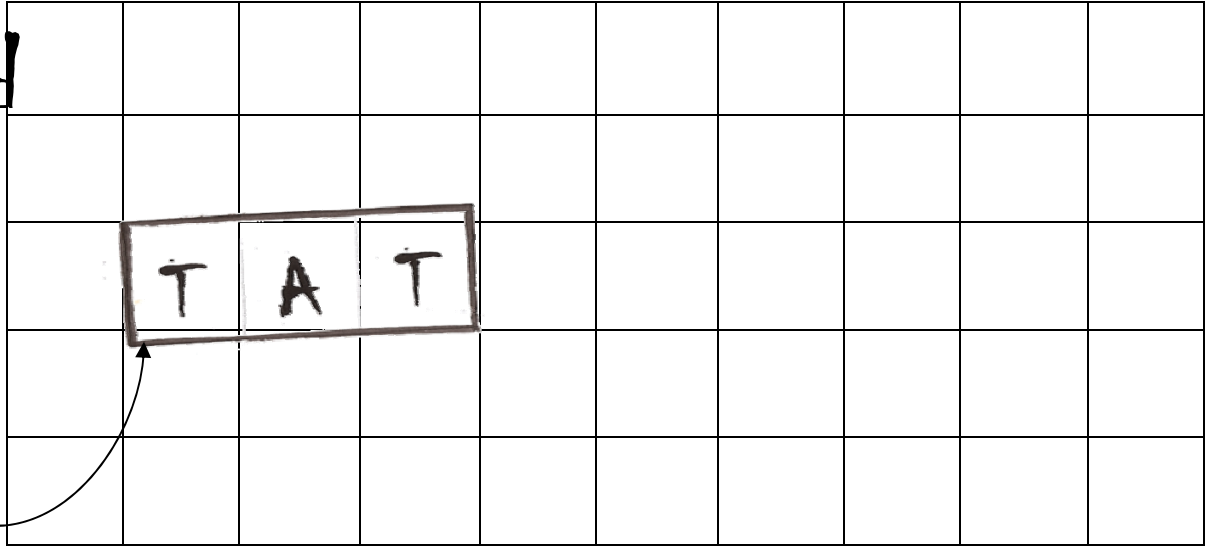
