THE JOURNEY

No more than a name, but each of their lives a marker in the history of God's relationship with man. For the Jews it all began with Abraham, the father of God's chosen people. From him came all the big names and events of Jewish and Christian history, and from his line eventually came Christ, the Savior of us all. 

TIPS for parents and teachers


CHANGE OF PLANS


Pilgrimage means: a journey to a holy place, undertaken for religious reasons
