#### What is Hell?


In Revelation we see God again and again giving the opportunity for the terror of the judgments to bring sinful mankind to a saving repentance. But the appeal of that is lessened if we avoid the topic of what we are saved from.

We have a problem with hell. We avoid the topic, and "good" people are reluctant to even say the word. To give it thought forces us to deal with the idea that yes, our sweet, loving Father is going to allow people, people that we know and love, to spend a horrible eternity apart from Him. It kind of wrecks our teddy bear image of a God who is more for our comfort and security than to reign as lord of our life. Those who go to hell have no desire to be with God in life, so their wish is granted in death. Whatever the desire on earth will be the "gift" for eternity. Those who want to be under God's rule go to heaven to serve Him in worship forever. Heaven just isn't the place for those who want to be their own master. Satan knew what heaven was like and still didn't want to be there because he wasn't the one calling the shots and getting the glory. So, God granted his wish just as He will also give us what we choose. Whatever we choose in life is our choice for eternity. The pure in heart will see God (Matt. 5:8) because that is their single-minded desire. God will not reveal to us what we do not wish to see. Heaven is for those who adore God, and hell is for those who adore self. Do we desire to live in the light or in the dark? To know of the horror of hell is to have our choice made clear. That's why God gives us glimpses through Scripture.




